LOCATION: Poynette State Game Farm, Town of Dekorra, Columbia County

PROJECT REQUEST: Select an A/E consulting firm to provide design through construction phase professional services associated with the design and construction of the Poynette Heavy Equipment Storage Facility in the Town of Dekorra, WI.

PROJECT NUMBER: 15J1M

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project will construct a 60' x 100' cold storage building at the State Game Farm in Poynette. The building will have 3 drive-thru bays and a large sliding door on the east side of the building. It will have a mezzanine level for additional storage area. This building will store farm machinery and equipment; pheasant transport crates; trucks; and trailers. The proposed location for this 6000 sq. ft. building is north of the Game Farm service road and immediately east of the "Doll House" (building #828) on the Game Farm campus.

JUSTIFICATION: Currently, the original garages are used to house 3 tractors, van, forklift, feed truck, bobcat skid steer, and the Gehl loader. The remaining machinery and equipment remain outside year-round, decreasing the operating life and reliability of the equipment. With the construction of a new storage building, the original garages will be used to store fleet vehicles and miscellaneous pen building materials (top netting, side wire, etc.) which currently sit outside.
