**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The purpose of the project is to provide adequate space and protection for existing vehicles and equipment to maintain mission readiness. The scope of work includes a military vehicle storage building (MVSB) addition to the north of the existing facility at 6001 Manufacturers Dr., Madison WI, 53704. The structure is proposed to align with the existing building width for a total additional area of 4,010sf in an area currently consisting of grass and an associated storm water inlet. Construction is to match the existing masonry and steel framed, building for overall building height and bay spacing, allowing for up to four new, pull thru bays. Lighting and ventilation are required and are to meet energy efficiency requirements to the fullest extent possible. The MVSB is to be an unheated building. Antiterrorism/Force Protection measures are to be included in the project. Vehicle access aprons will be included.

**PROJECT JUSTIFICATION:**

The existing facility includes a 5,400sf CST Ready Bay area featuring five pull thru bays for vehicles and equipment. The Ready Bays are inadequate in size to house the vehicles and equipment necessary to support this mission. Due to this, some equipment must be stored outdoors which causes quicker deterioration of the equipment as well as slower response time, especially during winter months. Since 2009 this unit's mission rate has more than doubled and they are now among the top 10 busiest teams among the 57 in the nation.
