I. REQUEST STATEMENT

The Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs is requesting the selection of an Architect/Engineer to provide full design services including construction administration for the renovation of Building #503 at the Wisconsin Veteran's Home – King.

II. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

A. Project Scope

In preparation for the demolition of Burns Clemens Hall, to make room for the new John R. Moses Skilled Nursing Facility, this project will renovate Building #503 Nurse's Quarters to accommodate the Staff Development Training Program, IS Training and DOA's Division of Facilities Development. It will remodel the existing apartment spaces into multiple training/conference rooms, offices, restrooms, and a kitchenette/break room. It will include the building of an environmentally controlled computer system server room in the basement.

The renovation includes asbestos abatement and demolishing inside walls on floors one and two; build-out of new spaces including replacement and re-routing, and repair of deficiencies in the structure, plumbing, electrical, and HVAC systems, and IT equipment and wiring. A ramp will be added to provide an ADA accessible entrance to the second floor.

C. Project Background and Existing Conditions

Building #503 Nurse's Quarters, also called Employee Dorm or Nurses Dorm, is an 8,500 Square Foot, two-story building of wood frame construction with a flat roof built in 1968. In the past, the building was used as employee apartments but needs to be remodeled into training and office space for operations displaced by the demolition of Burns Clemens Hall.

An evaluation of Building 503 was done in 2009 as part of a campus-wide building assessment. For more information about that review, see the Berners-Schober Associates Building Evaluation, 2009.
